




EU F-Gas Regulation proposal issued 7 Nov





EU targets to cut yearly fgas emissions by two-thirds by 2030

EU proposal: 79% HFC phase-down by 2030 in Shecco STANINGOUR ATMOSPHERE



HFC bans in EU proposal



Type of equipment	Ban applies as of
1. Domestic refrigeration	January 2015 for HFCs with GWP ≥ 150
2. Hermetically sealed refrigeration systems for commercial use	January 2017 if GWP ≥ 2,500 January 2020 for HFCs with 150 ≤ GWP ≤ 2,500
3. Movable air conditioning systems (hermetically-sealed)	January 2020 for HFCs with GWP ≥ 150


HFC bans in amended Swiss F-Gas policy (7 Nov)



HFC bans in Switzerland as of Dec. 2013	Proposed HFC bans in EU F-Gas Regulation
 1. Air conditioning systems for: cooling with a cooling capacity of more than 600 kW, cooling & heating by means of VRF or VRV systems with more than 40 evaporator units and cooling capacity > 80 kW, for local and district heating by heat pump with cooling capacity > 600 kW; 	1. Domestic refrigeration
 2. Commercial refrigeration systems for: minus cooling with a cooling capacity > 30 kW, plus cooling with cooling capacity > 40 kW; combined plus & minus cooling with a cooling capacity > 40 kW for plus cooling and 8 kW for minus cooling; 	2. Hermetically sealed refrigeration systems for commercial use
 3. Industrial refrigeration systems for: deep freezing with a cooling capacity > 100 kW, all other applications with a cooling capacity > 400 kW; 	3. Movable air conditioning systems (hermetically-sealed)
4. Ice rinks , except for temporary systems
