



in North America, including Mexico: around 4,000 units (March 2013)














HFC-free light-commercial refrigeration global industry leaders

approx. 950,000 HFC-free vending machines (Coca-Cola + Pepsi) 313,000 HFC-free bottle coolers (Red Bull)







75 stores with CO₂ cascade & secondary systems in 2012; already 25 new ones planned for 2013






Cascade & secondary systems dominate - Transcritical systems are coming!

CO₂ TC supermarkets: japan



140+ stores with transcritical CO₂ systems today

Transcritical systems dominate

CO₂ TC experience gained through 3.5 million CO₂-only heat pumps = 98% market share for residential heat pump water heaters


annual production: 500,000 units


MESSAGE 1: The current Natural Refrigerant use in North America is still low in most end-use applications, and as compared to other world regions!


