## Building on successful domestic policy and legislation

#### 2006 legislation:

- F-gas Regulation: containment and awareness raising
- Mobile air conditioning

#### 2010 policy:

Low carbon economy roadmap

#### 2014 legislation

• EU phase-down coupled with containment measures and selective placing on the market prohibitions





#### International action and the Montreal Protocol

- Keeping climate change below 2°C
- Low-cost mitigation
- Successful phase-out of ozone depleting substances
- G20 and others calling for the deployment of the mechanisms and institutions of the Montreal Protocol to deal with HFCs





#### An emerging EU proposal

A challenge for developed countries with a design to stimulate innovation


A fair deal for developing countries without putting in question their phase-out of ozone depleting substances
